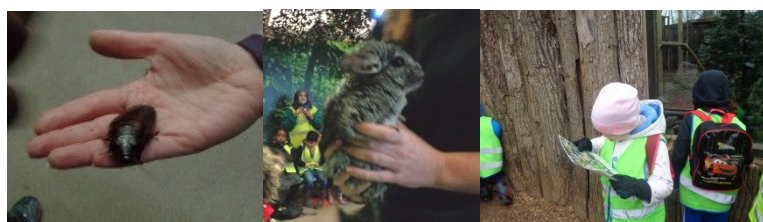
On Wednesday, Year 1 visited Twycross zoo.
