Some children have had duplicate nasal flu consent cards sent out this week. The school nurse team will be coming into school during October to provide flu vaccinations for year one and two. It is a painless nasal spray that can help protect your child from the flu virus. Please complete the consent form and return as soon as possible.

Reminder for Year 1 Parents

Please let your children go into class by themselves in the morning. As everyone can see, the cloakroom area in year 1 is very small and children need to be able to access their pegs easily. We are working hard to encourage your child to be independent. If you need to speak to the teacher please leave it until after school or make an appointment as the teacher's focus needs to be on the children as soon as they come into the classroom. Also, no one should be in the year 1 classroom without the teacher present. This is for health and safety reasons. Could parents/ carers please ensure they do not let their child go into the classroom if there is no teacher in the room.
