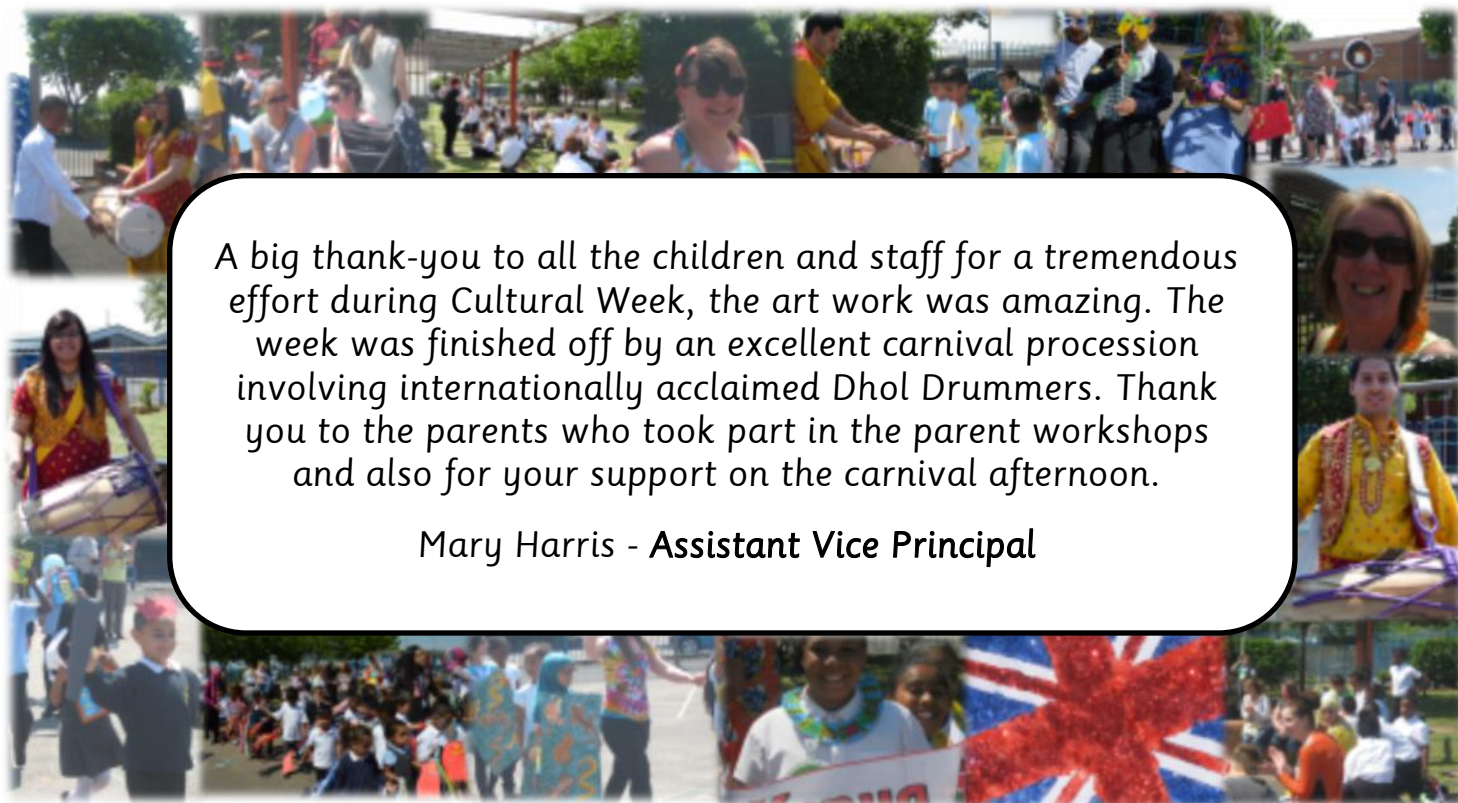

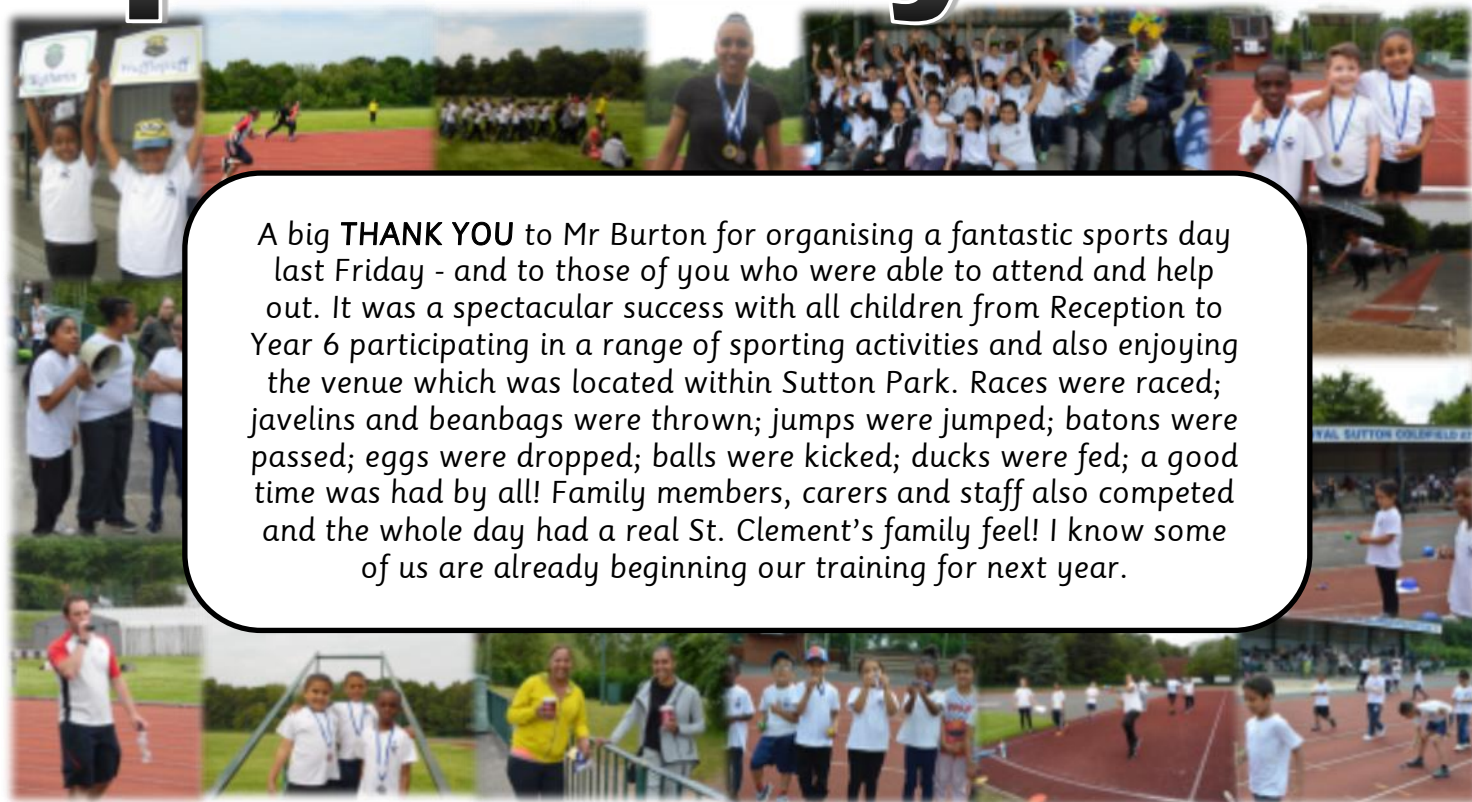
Cultural Week Carnival
